Dear Parent/Guardian:

Welcome to the 2024-25 school year! We are looking forward to a great year ahead. Once again, Diehl Elementary, a United Way community school, is partnering with Erie Family Center/Diaper Depot to provide Diehl's families with free diapers once a month. Orders for diapers will be placed the day after the deadlines listed below and the diapers will be given to your son/daughter to bring home. Please note: **We are starting a new school year, so all families must fill out a request for diapers – even if you have received them in the past.** We are limited to providing diapers for up to 75 babies per month. Once that number has been reached, a waiting list will be established. **IMPORTANT: Any child born BEFORE August 1, 2021 is not eligible to participate.**

If you received diapers last year, fill out the first and last section of the attached form. If you are new to the program, fill out the entire form and have your child return the form to Diehl. It your responsibility to let the community school director know when your baby's diaper size changes. New enrollments or diaper size changes must be in by the monthly deadline date listed below. If you are enrolled and the diaper size is the same, you don't have to do anything. Diapers will automatically be ordered for you. Refer to the schedule below:

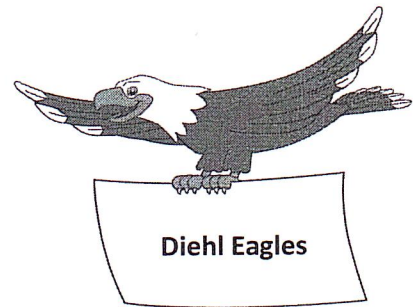

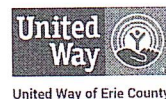
