AP/ IV Spanish Summer Assignment-

Please do all activities completely and to the best of your ability. You will receive a grade for completing each of these assignments, so do good work to get off to a good start. It will require self-discipline and dedication on your part as this class will be treated and taught as if it were a college course. That said, cheating of any kind is not tolerated. All work needs to be your own- without using translators, asking Spanish speaking friends to do assignments, or plagiarizing work from the internet. If you cheat- you only cheat yourself and lower the quality of the class! I have been doing this a long time, and I can tell you that you get out of it what you put into it. One acceptable resource for vocabulary help is www.wordreference.com. This is an accurate dictionary. Translators do not show a true representation of you!

The Assignments

I will create an assignment link on Schoology for each assignment where you can turn them in when completed.

1. Listening Practice-

Listen to three different selections of Notes in Spanish at the intermediate and advanced level. For each one, write summary in Spanish about what you heard. You may listen to the selections as many times as you need to in order to understand them. In each summary, tell me the name of the selection, if it is intermediate or advanced, and at least one new thing that you learned as result of listening to your chosen selection. Keep a log of your listening selections to be collected the first day of school.

2. Poem- Queda Prohibido por Pablo Neruda

Learn and practice vocabulary from the poem (Blooket) and then read **Queda Prohibido**. Break down each of the “consejos” in each stanza in your own words and answer questions at the end of the poem. Be ready to use the poem, its

advice and the new vocabulary to write an email to a troubled friend when we return to school. There will also be a quiz on the vocab from the story. Everything is on Schoology.

3. Grammar Practice-

As for grammar, I know that you are at different ability and knowledge levels. This is to be expected. I have included a packet called Essential Spanish Grammar in the Summer Assignment Schoology page. The areas that you need to study and master this summer are:

Present tense- regular, irregular, stem-changing	Commands (familiar)
Preterite – regular, irregular, stem-changing	Future
Imperfect – regular and irregular	Para vs. Por
Ser vs. Estar	Direct and Indirect Object pronouns
Present subjunctive	Para vs Por

Keep a log of your practices, and how well you do. Reflect on your strengths and weaknesses so I know where our strengths and weaknesses are as a group. I have added a Spanish grammar survival guide with everything in it into Schoology! I will add GimKits, Quizziz activities and Kahoots for you to practice grammar. You can also visit this website to practice and review any and all grammar points. You will have grammar quizzes when we return in the fall.
