

A concert for families with last names starting with A-K will be held at 8:30 am and another concert for families with last names starting with L-Z will be held at 9:45 am. If you have students in both shows, please attend the show for the oldest child. Both concerts will be held on the same day this year, Thursday, December 19th, in the auditorium. For safety reasons, once all the auditorium seats are all taken, no more spectators will be permitted.

Students can wear holiday colors, festive, or dressy attire. On Thursday, December 12th, students will participate in a dress rehearsal and the EPS audio/visual crew will be taping this session. Parents/guardians are not permitted. Students should wear red/green shirts for the dress rehearsal, if possible. The dress rehearsal will be aired on Spectrum cable channel 1023 over the December holiday break and will also be viewable on the EPS YouTube channel.
