

PBIS BEHAVIOR MATRIX

Minor Behaviors

Inappropriate behavior that makes it difficult for others to learn but does NOT threaten the health and safety of others.

Examples: shouting out, running, out of seat, refusal to do work, cursing, outbursts, throwing small objects, pushing, making noises, touching others, being mean.

5 MINORS = 1 Office Referral

Major Behaviors

Inappropriate behavior that makes it difficult for others to learn and may threaten the health and safety of others.

Examples: bullying, leaving the classroom, making threats, stealing, vandalism, physical fighting.

Staff will determine if this is handled as minor behavior or if it automatically goes to the office.

Cell Phone Policy

Cell phones and electronics are to be silent and away in the classroom.

Students earn a **PBIS Point** for putting their cell phone away and another point at the end of the day for not using their phone.

1st Violation: Reminder of expectation.

2nd Violation: Issue a warning that the phone will be confiscated by the principal.

3rd Violation: Phone is confiscated, family is notified and phone is returned at the end of the day.

After the phone is confiscated 3 times a meeting will be scheduled with the family and the student will have a 1 hour detention and then a suspension.

Office Referrals

Behavior that threatens the health and safety of others automatically goes to the office.

Examples: weapons, drugs, terroristic threats, physical acts of violence.

Dress Code Violations

If a student violates the dress code policy, then the family will be contacted to bring school appropriate clothing.

If the family cannot be reached, then clothing will be provided and a letter will be sent home with the student.

If the violation continues, then the student will have to serve detentions and/or suspensions.
